This certificate provides students with the opportunity to learn about and apply techniques that are foundational to effective leadership which encourage positive organizational practices and move organizations toward adaptable and contemporary outcomes.

Objectives

This 18-hour Certificate in Organizational Leadership is an alternative to the complete Master of Arts in Organizational Leadership for students looking to build critical leadership skills. This certificate does not require a thesis. Students who earn the Certificate in Organizational Leadership will understand leadership theories and leadership as a social phenomenon, use critical thinking and decision-making skills to enhance leadership and organizational effectiveness, develop foundational notions of ethical leadership with a focus on Lasallian and Servant Leadership, and recognize the role of leadership in shaping organizational culture with particular emphasis on diversity, engagement, and self-reflection.
