Applicants who do not meet one or more of these criteria may apply for provisional admission but must submit a personal statement for review by SGPCE. The personal statement outlines a plan for achieving success in an adult accelerated program at Lewis University. Transfer admissions counselors guide applicants through the process. Credits earned through Prior Learning Assessment cannot be used to satisfy the transfer credit hour requirement for admission into an accelerated program.
